Ibn Sina expressed valuable opinions about child education and methods of education. Ibn Sina, in his comments on the moral education of the child, also talks about the issues of household maintenance. Raising a child is the main goal and duty of a family parent. A parent who is able to correct their own shortcomings can be an educator. The most important means of moral education is to give advice to the child without touching his ego and pride. Muslihiddin Sadi Shirozi, one of the great exponents of Eastern classical literature, was born in the city of Shiroz in 1184. According to Sadi, the family is the foundation for a child's happiness and future. The main support in the family is the father. He is a responsible educator.
