DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM IN UZBEKISTAN

Abstract: Nowadays, tourism has become popular in many countries of the world. Usually, tourism is organized according to tourist routes through tourist organizations. There are many types and forms of tourism domestic, international, amateur tourism, organized tourism, local travel, long-distance travel, educational tourism, climbing, water tourism, auto tourism, hiking tourism, sports tourism.

On the basis of the reforms implemented in the country, an urgent task is set to achieve continuous economic growth in exchange for economic liberalization, modernization of the country, and ensuring macroeconomic stability. This, in turn, is evaluated as the basis of the achievements in the economy, as the settlement of market relations, the improvement of property forms, the occurrence of sharp changes in the economy, and the increase in the share of service and service industries in the gross domestic product. Because of this, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, I. A. Karimov, "it is extremely important to further expand the sphere of services to the population... At the same time, these services increase the domestic demand for many types of products manufactured in our country, as well as increase the proportion in the consumer market storage plays an important role.

Despite the fact that the global financial and economic crisis has a negative impact on the economy, in 2009, in Uzbekistan, the gross domestic product increased by 8.1 percent, the volume of industrial output increased by 9 percent, the production of consumer goods increased by 13.9 percent, and paid services to the population display volume increased by 12.9%, including turn over by 16.6%.

In his speech at the joint meeting of the Legislative Chamber and the Senate of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan on November 12, 2010, the President emphasized this issue: "... our most important task in the near future is to consistently continue the work we have started ... is to pay special attention to the development of the service sector, infrastructure facilities, and the implementation of transport and communication projects.[1]

It can be seen from this that in the process of modernizing the economy of the current country, it is required to improve the organizational and economic mechanism of sustainable economic development of service enterprises in the conditions of constantly changing market relations, increasing the efficiency of their economic activity.

Because it is necessary to ensure the intensity of service delivery related to the organizational and economic mechanism of increasing the efficiency of service enterprises, to achieve savings in the use of resources, to increase the efficiency of the use of the labor of employees and the quality of service and its effectiveness, The issues of fully satisfying consumer demand are one of the specific problems of the industry. Also, increasing the level and quality of services of local enterprises in the international market and increasing the export of services based on this is one of the main tasks of today.

Also, President I. A. Karimov, in his speech at the meeting of the Cabinet of Ministers on January 22, 2011, "Last year, 13.4 percent growth was achieved in the service sector, and in the last ten years, the volume of services per capita has increased almost 20 times"4. In fact, the rapid development of tourism, which is an important component of the service network, is one of the priority directions of our country's economy. In the years of independence, a number of regulatory documents aimed at increasing the efficiency of tourism and developing the tourism market in our republic, including the "State Program for the Development of Tourism in Uzbekistan until 2005" and the Law "On Tourism" (August 20, 1999) was accepted. On April 17, 2006, the Presidential Decree "On measures to accelerate the development of the service sector in the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2006-2010" was adopted.[3]

The role of the service sector in improving people's quality of life is incomparable. That is why this field is constantly developing on the scale of the countries of the world. The development of the service sector is also given great importance in our country. For example, by 2010, its share in the country's GDP is expected to reach 49.0%.[2]

With the formation and deepening of market relations, the service sector in our republic, further development, creation of a competitive environment, various new and extremely important issues are being put on the agenda in the current complex conditions. Among them, the issue of improving the quality and efficiency of hotel services in the field of tourism occupies a very important place.[4]

The President said, "An important issue that requires special attention in the structural renewal is to ensure the rapid development of the service sector. They noted that the draft program for the development of services and service industries for 2010-2016 should be submitted for approval, in which the share of this sector in the gross domestic product of our country should reach 54-56%. In fact, it is important to eliminate the effects of the global financial and economic crisis in the conditions of Uzbekistan and to diversify the economy, effective operation of service enterprises in the process of structural renewal, and it is necessary to improve the organizational and economic mechanism of increasing the efficiency of their economic activity.[4]

In the period of economic liberalization, the lack of theoretical and practical scientific work on improving the efficiency of service enterprises at the level of regions indicates the special relevance of this topic. Also, President I. A.
